Anti - Ragging Cell

Ragging has ruined countless innocent lives and careers. In order to eradicate it, Hon'ble Supreme Court in Civil Appeal No. 887 of 2009, passed the judgement wherein guidelines were issued for setting up of a Central Crisis Hotline and Anti-Ragging database.

The Anti- Ragging CELL was constituted in the College in 2018 as per the UGC Regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009. The UGC has accorded top most priority to curtail the menace of ragging in Institution of higher education. Details of the action taken against the complaints is also available at the website <u>www.antiragging.in</u> & <u>www.amanmovement.org</u>. Ragging is a criminal offence as per West Bengal Act 1983 and Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. NETAJI NAGAR COLLEGE ensures strict compliance on the prevention of Ragging in any form.

Legal Definition of Ragging

Ragging means "Causing, inducing, compelling or forcing a student, whether by way of practical joke or otherwise, to do any act which detracts from human dignity or violates his/her person or exposes him/her to ridicule from doing any lawful act".

The 3rd Amendment of UGC Regulations on "Curbing the menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2016.According to this: 3(j) Any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (Fresher or otherwise) on the ground of colour, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence or economic background.

Ragging in all its forms is totally banned in this college whether located within the campus or outside. The college shall take strict action including but not limited to criminal proceeding and/or cancellation of admission against those found guilty of ragging and/or of abetting ragging and the burden of proof shall hereby lie on the perpetrator of alleged ragging and not on the victim. An offence of Ragging may be charged either on a written complaint by the affected or on independent finding of the Anti Ragging Cell.

Objective: To prohibit any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student, or

indulging in rowdy or in disciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.

What constitutes Ragging?

Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:

- Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
- Indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.
- Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.
- Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
- Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students.
- Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, and stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person.
- Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.
- Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student.

Administrative action in the event of ragging:-

The institution shall punish a student found guilty of ragging after following the Procedure and in the manner prescribed here in under:

- a) The Anti-Ragging Committee of the Institution shall take an appropriate decision, In regard to punishment or otherwise, depending on the facts of each incident of Ragging and nature and gravity of the incident of ragging established in the recommendations of the Anti-Ragging Squad.
- b) The **Anti-Ragging Committee may**, depending on the nature and gravity of the guilt established by the Anti-Ragging Squad, award, **to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments, namely;**
 - i. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.

- ii. With holding/ withdrawing scholarship/ fellowship and other benefits
- iii. Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation Process.
- iv. Withholding results.
- v. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or International meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- vi. Suspension/ expulsion from the hostel.
- vii. Cancellation of admission.
- viii. Rustication from the institution for period ranging from one to four semesters
- ix. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution, for a specified period.
