

They will also gain systematic subject skills in the areas of commerce, business, accounting, economics, finance, auditing and marketing. Students will be able to recognise and sync with the features and roles of businessmen, entrepreneur, managers, consultant in the society. The base work to prove proficiency in competitive exams like CA, CS,CMA and other coursesis also achieved by the advanced learners of this course. Additionally students imbibe the skills for effective communication, decision making, problem solving in day to day business affairs. They also acquire practical skills to workas tax consultant, audit assistant and other financial support services. This graduate course opens the field of higher education and advance research in commerce and finance.

Department of English Course Outcome

CC1:- History of English Literature & CC2:-- and Classical European Literature

<u>Aims:</u> These two papers aim to provide a rock solid foundation to the students of English Honours course. The 1st paper aims to equip the students with a chronological understanding of the historical development of literature. The 2nd paper provides students with a better humanitarian perspective on literature.

Such a proper training equips the students to become better writers, journalists and reviewers.

CC4, 7, 8, 9, 10, 12 – British Literature of different time periods

These papers mainly focus on British Literature and its journey through different genres and techniques of writing. As a student of English Literature, these are essential aspects for having a better and clear understanding of the intended contents of the course.

These papers enable the students to develop creative ideas and skill to play with words, which can be very helpful in the creative writing industry. Also through this process of studying a foreign literature and learning about its people, a student develops an understanding of the 'other-self', feel compassionate towards them; which can be a great skill for being a successful P.R (Public Relations) in different industrial sections.

CC3:- Indian Writing in English; CC11:- Women Writings; & CC14:- Postcolonial Literatures

These papers intend to give the students a different perspective of English Literature by focusing on important and relevant aspects like the literary works by women and literatures of the postcolonial period.

This provides the students a greater scope to indulge themselves more deeply in the realm of literature, which can be useful while they choose their careers as anchors, news readers, magazine editors or copywriters.

DSE-B2:-- Women and Empowerment; & DSE-A4:-- Media and Communication Studies

These papers deal with the subjects like: Social Construction of Gender, History of Women's Movement in India (pre-independence and post-independence), Women and Law: Domestic Violence, Female Foeticide, Harassment and Marginalisation, as well as Mass Communication and Globalisation, Writing Pamphlets, Posters etc, Advertisements and Creating Advertisements These are practically helpful for the students who want to join the media industry or have inclinations towards different social services and social works through the NGO's.

SEC-A1:- Translation Studies; & SEC-B1:-- Creative Writing

The first paper focuses on the importance of translation in a multi-linguistic and multi-cultural society, like India, and different types of translations like: Literal translation, Free translation & Transcreation. The second paper looks into the different modes of creative writing and gives a practical understanding on writing short Story / Poetry and Preparing for publication.


Through the knowledge of different aspects of Translation studies and the proper skill to translate, a student can choose a translator's job or can be an interpreter. Practical involvement in the process of creative writing enables a student to develop creative ideas and build constructive and logical arguments. It also helps to clearly describe, communicate and summarize any topic and develop the ability to decode and understand different theories, concepts and also enrich the researching skills. These can be very helpful for becoming a writer or newspaper editor by profession.

In MacBeth, it is interesting to see how the relationship between Macbeth and Lady Macbeth changes as the play progresses. They begin as partners in crime but drift apart rapidly after Duncam's murder. Lady Macbeth shares her husband's lust for power, and her frence goading in Act I leads him to murder king Duncam in and seize the throne of Scotland. He is reluctant and Jears detection. He recognises that the deed is evil, but lady Macbeth's ferocious will inspires him with the perverse intensity necessary to overcome his scruptes. However, the evils unleashed by the murder prove too much for the new queen, and she goes insane. Reduced to sleep-walking and hallucinations in she eventually dies, as is reported in, Her death is declared a suicide in 5.9.

Lady Macketh's principal importance lies in her ability to influence her husband early in the play when she wiges him to murder the king. Bengalee woman Revolutionary Pritilata Wadeddar

SURAJ KUMAR JHA (B.A.HISTORY HONS. SEMESTER- 4)

Pritilata Waddedar was a Benga-li revolutionary nationalist from tilata went to Calcutta and got admitted the Indian subcontinent who was influential in the Indian independence movement. Pritilata was born in a middle-class Vaidya (Baidya) family on 5 May 1911, in Dhalghat village in Patiya upazila of Chittagong. Waddedar was a

title conferred to an ancestor of the family who originally had the surname Dasgupta. Her father Jagaband-hu Waddedar was a clerk in the Chittagong

Municipality, Her mother Pratibhamavi Devi was a housewife. The couple had six children - Madhusduan, Pritilata, Kanaklata, Shantilata, Ashalata and Santosh. Pritilata was nicknamed Rani. Pritilata passed out of Dr. Khastagir Government Girls' School of Chittagong in 1928 and in 1929, got admitted to the Eden College, Dhaka. In the Intermediate examinations, she stood first among all students who appeared in that year's examination from the Dhaka Board. As a student in Eden College, she participated in various social activities. She joined the group Sree Sangha, headed by Leela Nag, under the banner Deepali

to the Bethune College. Two years later, she graduated in Philosophy from the college with a distinction. However, her degree was withheld by British authorities at Calcutta University, she and Bina Das were conferred their certificates of



took up the job of headmistress at a local English medium secondary school called Nandankanan Aparnacharan School.

Pritilata Wadeddar wanted to dedicate her life to Nationalist movement. On 13 June 1932, Pritilata met Surjo Sen and Nirmal Sen in their Dhalghat camp. A contemporary revolutionary, Binod Bihari Chowdhury, says that "Pritilata was young and courageous. She would work with a lot of zeal and was determined to drive the British away" he also objected that they did not allow women to join their group. However, Pritalata was allowed to join the group because

atangini Hazra born in 17th No-Wember,1870 was an Indian Revolutionary who participated in the Indian National Movement for Freedom. She was born in a poor peasant family of Hogla village within Tamluk Police Station area . She was the daughter of Thakurdas Maity and Bhagawati Devi.


At very young age Matangini was mar-ried to Trilochan Hazra of Alinan village,(with the same police station). She lost her husband at the age of eighteen and had to follow strict schedule. On 26th January 1932, the local congress volunteers under the leadership of Gandhar Bhowmik, (prominent freedom fighters and local congress organiser) set out a procession in order to observe the Independence Day. A few girls with conchshells in their hands were in front of that procession.

When the procession came close to the house of Matangini Devi, she could not restrain herself from joining it. Then she marched through different villages and reached Krishnaganj in a public meeting Where she took oath of joining the nationalist movement. She even took the vow in the name of Gandhiji to give up her habit of taking opium. Then she joined Civil Disobedience Movement of 1932 and was arrested several times for

breaking the Salt Act in the Alinan Salt manufacturing center. In that year she led many processions and even raised the National Flag in the Tamluk Police Station and in Tamluk Diwani Adalat. She also participated in No-Tax Campaign and went from door to door to persuade the villagers not to pay a single pie to the government as tax of any kind. During 1932 and 1933, when John Anderson, the Governor of Bengal came to Tamluk to address an assembly, Matangini Devi led a procession with black flags in her hands and shouting "Go back Governor" slogans as a protest against the inhumane torture upon the innocent people, both men and women .

As a result she was arrested and sen-tenced to Six months rigorous imprisonment. After her release from the jail she engaged herself in different constructive programmes like the introduction of Charkha and Khadi , removal of un-touchability, prevention of liquors and others

In 1935 she became engaged in relief works among the flood affected people of Tamluk with Kumar Chandra Jana, then the president of Tamluk Subdivisional Congress Committee. From 1932-1942 she became the most active worker o

Gender Audit Report

Report on Gender Audit: Prepared Dr. Sarbani Goswami, Sr. Research Officer, School of Women's Studies, Jadavpur University

Report

This report has been prepared by the undersigned on the basis of the report prepared by the Netajinagar College, Evening Branch and by talking to some of the students who studied in this college and the Principal of the College helped to perceive the gender neutral ambience of the college.

Netajinagar college was established in 1967 with the objective of educating the local community surrounding the college.

One has to analyse the history of the area before delving in to the analysis of gender. Gender analysis refers to the variety of methods used to understand the relationships between men and women, their access to resources , their activities and the constraints they face relative to each other. It is an essential element in socio economic analysis.

The area or the colony was set up during the time when the then Calcutta was witnessing post partition problems of rehabilitation and reintegration. The communities arriving from East Bengal wanted to provide their families not only safe homes but also making both men and women enlightened and empowered. Therefore education and empowerment was given the foremost priority within the paradigm of rehabilitation and reintegration.

While going through the report and in conversation with the Principal I made up my mind that my analysis of gender audit should also take into consideration the community outside the college as they are bound to provide an input in the gender role and relationships.

	A gender audit analysis implies mainstreaming of gender by changing various gender sensitive aspects of the Institutional principles culture and ethos which discriminate against women.

Observation:

The college has methodically tried to identify gender role in the society and accordingly has set up committees to facilitate mainstreaming of gender.

It has recognised the gender patterns within their composition , structures, processes, administrative and academic culture, design and delivery of services to both men and women students staff and teachers.

The gender equality cell helps in assessing the impact of gender performance in establishing gender equality within the organisation.

The gender equality cell supports and recommends measures to the college in identifying challenges and gender gaps and procedures of improvement.

By establishing the Gender Equality Cell the college internally fosters gender equality and initiates capacity building of both men and women.

Though the Cell functions within a small budget, it has professionally arranged and organised itself to confront the challenges of gender mainstreaming through a human rights approach.

Recommendations:

Gender Audit or a Gender Audit policy is basically a rights based approach to the mainstreaming of gender.

- 1.Disabilities and inequalities imposed on women maybe seen from the context of the society.
- 2.The college should conduct survey on a regular basis to assess the extent of gender equality that has been perceived within the college community. For example, do the Teachers, Students, Staff have the inclination towards making gender equality a priority. Do they have the awareness of the knowledge of gender equality.
- 3.Accountability regarding both gender equity and equality should be fostered. This would help in help in the continuous process of interrogating Gender.
- 4. A specific budget should be available for activities designed to achieve gender equality.
- 5. The college along with the Gender Equality Cell should organise sensitisation and advocacy programmes at a regular basis among the college community as well as among the community outside the college to bring in the parity among all.
- 6. Seminars, Lectures and participatory lectures should be encouraged to help in creating a dialogue among all.
- 7. Gender based research should be encouraged among students, teachers ,staffs.
- 8. The college should also facilitate support services to both male and female, differently abled persons.

In conclusion, I would like to point out that equality does not mean attaining the same standard as rich and powerful but rather questioning the roots of power and domination so that the domination and oppression can be challenged on the path of TOWARDS EQUALITY.



- Objective: Ashapurna Devi, a prominent Bengali woman novelist (1905-1995) focused on women's creativity and enlightenment during the colonial and post-colonial period in Bengal, India. She herself displayed immense will power, tenacity and an indomitable spirit which enable her to eke out a prominent place for herself in the world of creative writing. Her writings trace the evolution of the Bengali woman as an enlightened and empowered individual struggling against the shackles of discriminatory norms imposed upon her by society. She traces the extremely conservative upbringing that the female members of her generation were subjected to and goes on to show how different individuals responded to these structures in different ways. Some would comply unquestioningly, some would comply simply because they did not dare to protest, while others would break free and find their own niche in the outside world. These issues are addressed by Ashapurna Devi in many short stories. Some works of Ashapurna Debi such as Pratham Pratisruti(1964), Subarnalata(1967), and Bakulkatha(1974) deserve special mention.




